## Olaf Paper Bag Craft

## Materials:

white paper bag
glue
scissors
something to color with
Optional: large wiggly eyes

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Color the pieces as appropriate and cut them out.
- 2. Look at your paper bag:
  - a. It should be closed and flat like a piece of paper.
  - b. On one side, it's all smooth. This will be the <u>BACK</u> of your puppet.
  - c. On the other side there's a flippy tab (which is typically the bottom of the bag when you're carrying your lunch around...)
    This flippy tab will be the <u>HEAD</u>.
  - d. Lift the flippy tab up a bit. Underneath the tab will be the mouth. When the child puts their hand in the bag, they'll be able to make the puppet talk.
  - e. Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (The 3/4 or so of the bag below the part with the flippy tab) This will be the BODY.
  - f. Look at the sides of the bag. There should be a FLAP of paper. We'll be slipping the arms into this flap.
- 3. Glue the eyes onto the head.
- 4. Glue the carrot nose onto the head, underneath the eyes.
- 5. Glue the large black mouth under the flippy tab so it is visible when the mouth is closed.
- 6. Glue the teeth under the flippy tab so they are still visible when the mouth is closed.
- 7. Glue the twiggy "hair" onto the top of the head.
- 8. Glue the arms into the FLAP.
- 9. Glue the three buttons down the center of the body.
