**Orsemus and Edward Clark Born: 1808 Orsemus and 1812 Edward**

Drowned in Leland Pond on their birthday.

**Polly Lumbard Cleveland Born: 1782**

Died at the young age of 100! Wife of Dr. Wm. P. Cleveland.

**Dwight Cross Born: 1835**

Ran the G&D Cross Foundry with his older brother Geo. At the foundry, they made stoves and farm implements. He used to live where the "Copper Turret" is now.

**Abel DeForest Born: 1795**

When Morrisville re-incorporated as a village in 1848, Abel was chosen as the Village President (the village did not have a mayor at that time). It was said that he was chosen because he installed the first sidewalks in Morrisville.

**Harriet Dunham Born: 1795**

Cast iron headstone, probably manufactured by the Cross Foundry.

**Susanna Phelps Gage Born: 1857**

An embryologist at Cornell University. Donated her parents house on Main St. to the Village to become a library, as it is still today!

**Benjamin Graham Born: 1806**

Ran a water-powered saw and grist mill on Mill St. Has a zinc headstone in the cemetery.

**Samuel Green Born: 1753**

Fought in the Battle of Valley Forge during the Revolutionary War from December 1777 to June 1778.

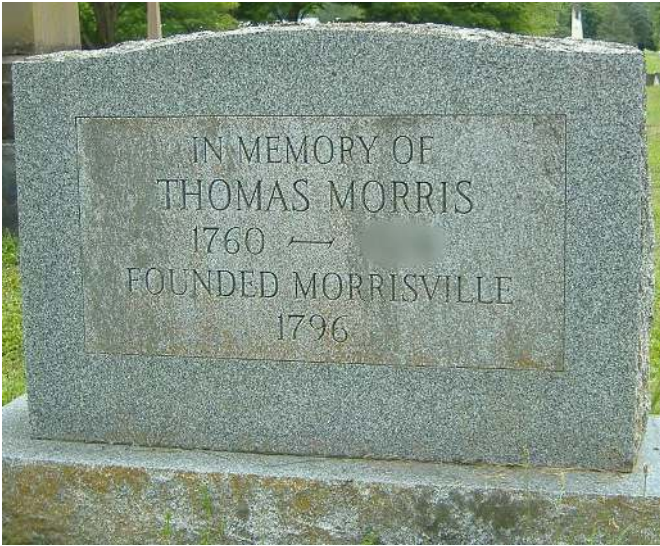

**Johnathan C. Gurley Born: 1793**

Born in Connecticut and came to Morrisville in 1827. In 1830 he opened up a comb factory on Main St. The combs the company manufactured were made from cow horns. From 1853 to 1862, he ran a silk factory on the corner of Union St. and Maple St.

**Thomas Morris Born: 1760**

Founder of Morrisville, which when he founded it, was called Morris Flats. Came to Morris Flats from Connecticut in 1796.

**Bradley Tillinghast Born: 1807**

Came to Morrisville in 1830 and started a tannery/leather factory. His house was what is now "The Fort."

**Otis H. Tillinghast Born: 1823**

Former Captain in the U.S. Army, and Bradley Tillinghast's nephew. He was mortally wounded in the First Battle of Bull Run during the Civil War.
